

HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

Purpose

This document follows the principles of OHSAS18001 & ISO 45001 and is intended to ensure that the activities and members of staff and contractors working on our behalf do not put the Health & Safety of themselves and others at risk. The arrangements, organisation and responsibilities for its implementation and revision are detailed in the Safety Manual.

Policy Aims:

- Comply with all Health & Safety Legislation, Regulations, Codes of Practice and Guidance Notes as a minimum acceptable level of performance.
- Ensure our activities are conducted safely, protecting the health of employees and all others who may be affected.
- Value the efforts of all employees in the field of Health & Safety equally with their other contributions to the business and consult with employees on safety issues.
- Strive to reduce accidents and injuries to a minimum.

In order to achieve our aims we will:

- Provide and maintain safe and healthy working conditions for all our employees and all others who work on our behalf.
- Ensure that risk assessments are being carried out on an on-going basis with employees participating in the risk assessment process.
- Require every employee, and others who work on our behalf, to exercise personal responsibility in preventing harm to themselves and others.
- Actively work to prevent all workplace accidents.
- Maintain a system for setting and reviewing safety objectives.
- Encourage the open reporting of all accidents and their investigation to facilitate the prevention of recurrence.
- Provide such information, instruction and training as needed to enable employees to co-operate fully with us in achieving compliance with the policy.
- Arrange for the effective planning, organisation, control, monitoring and review of preventive and protective measures.
